



Strengthening Fight against COVID-19 OPaL Donates 12 Lakh to Narhari Hospital

Since the outbreak, the hospital has initiated its fight against COVID19 by creating a capacity to house 100 COVID patients at a time with normal support of Oxygen at a very reasonable rate. The hospital was in urgent need of additional 5 units of ventilators along with central monitoring system. The approximate per unit cost comes to Rs. 12 lakh. OPaL handed the cheque worth Rs. 12 Lakh to the hospital authorities to procure 1 unit of ventilator.
